Executive Summary Of The Constitution And (Singapore Chapter)



By-Laws Of The Harley Owners Group

ARTICLE 2 - NAME

The name of this Society shall be the: *Harley Owners Group (Singapore Chapter)*

ARTICLE 3 – PLACE OF BUSINESS

Its place of business shall be at “253 Alexandra Road, #01-04 Singapore 159936” or such other address as may subsequently be decided upon by the Committee and approved by the Registrar of Societies. The Society shall carry out its activities only in places and premises which have the prior written approval from the relevant authorities, where necessary.

ARTICLE 4 – OBJECTIVES

The Objectives of the Society are:

- a. To promote road safety and road safety awareness among its members and the public.
- b. To raise funds for charitable purposes.
- c. To promote the interest and enthusiasm in the ownership, preservation and driving of Harley Davidson Motorcycles in Singapore.
- d. To promote a positive image of safe motorcycling in Singapore.

ARTICLE 6 – MEMBERSHIP

Section 1: Kinds

This Society shall have two kinds of membership, namely: Ordinary and Associate. Membership is open to the categories of persons set out below, who are willing to abide by the Constitution of the Society and execute a release and indemnity in a prescribed form.

Section 2: Ordinary Membership

Ordinary membership to the Society is open to all full members of Harley Owners Group International who:

- a. have fully paid all their dues to Harley Owners Group International; and
- b. are composed of good character and reputation; and
- c. are over eighteen (18) years of age.

Ordinary Members have full voting rights within the Society to the extent that each Ordinary Member may exercise one vote at each ballot of the Society. For Ordinary Members, the membership of the Society shall terminate automatically upon the expiry or termination of their membership of Harley Owners Group International.

Section 3: Associate Membership

Associate membership to the Society is open to all associate members of Harley Owners Group International who:

- a. have fully paid all their dues to Harley Owners Group International; and
- b. are composed of good character and reputation.

Associate Members have no voting rights within the Society. For Associate Members, the membership of the Society shall terminate automatically upon the expiry or termination of their membership of Harley Owners Group International.

ARTICLE 6 (BY-LAWS) – FEES AND DUES

Section 1 – Admission

The admission fee shall be S\$30.00 or such sum as approved by the Committee with the consent and the resolution of the general membership, to be paid before the applicant can qualify as a member.

Section 2 - Membership

The membership dues shall be S\$50.00 per annum for Ordinary Members and S\$30.00 for Associate Members. The membership dues may be amended by the Committee from time to time, with the consent and the resolution of the members.

When a member is a serving Life Member of the Harley Owners Group International, and only in those circumstances, that member may elect to pay their membership dues for two or three years in advance, the sums due being S\$95.00 or S\$135.00 respectively in recognition of their commitment to the Harley Owners Group.

The Membership Dues shall automatically be considered overdue on 1st August, regardless of whether any such notice is given. This will lead to the termination of membership as provided for in the Constitution of the Society and require the admission fee and annual dues to be paid for new membership.

Section 3 – Additional Fees

The Society may impose additional fees on the members for participation in each activity or event. Such participation by the members shall be optional.

ARTICLE 16 – VISITORS AND GUESTS

Non-members may be permitted to participate as guests in the events or activities organised by the Society upon the invitation of a member and the payment of the prescribed fee for such event or activity.

The inviting member shall be responsible for the proper conduct of his guests at such event or activity. If, by decision of the Committee, the behaviour of any guest at any event or activity is undesirable; the Committee may refuse to allow that particular guest to participate in future events or activities.
